- (1) Project Name: Coal Thermal Power Plant Project
- (2) Project Site: Bihar, India
- (3) Project Outline: Construction and operation of coal thermal power plant
- (4) Category: A
- (5) Reason of Categorization: The project is a large-scale thermal power project which falls into Category A under JBIC Environment Guideline.
- (6) Environmental Permission: EIA on this project has been approved by Ministry of Environment and Forest.
- (7) Anti-Pollution Measures: The planned value for air quality (SO₂, NO_x, SPM), warm drainage water and the quality of the water are compliant with the local standard.
- (8) Natural Environmental Considerations: The project site is not located in the nature refuge designated by the host country government.
