- (5) Reason for Classification
The project falls under the category of large-scale oil and gas development, and has sensitive areas and sensitive characteristics in the surrounding region, as set forth by the JBIC Environmental Guidelines (April 2002).
- (6) Environmental Permits and Approvals
It is confirmed that approvals concerning environmental and social considerations have been made by the Secretary of the Environment and Natural Resources (SEMARNAT).
- (7) Pollution Mitigation Measures
The planned level of air quality complies with standards of United Mexican States and is below/within the applicable international standards (the World Bank Group). Planned levels of noise and water quality comply with the standards of the United Mexican States, and the waste generated by the project will also be disposed properly under the standards of the United Mexican States.
- (8) Natural Environment
Whereas there is a sensitive area (protected area) in the region surrounding this project site, the activities will not be implemented

within that area. In the case that deforestation is unavoidable, an equivalent amount of afforestation shall be implemented.

(9) Social Environment

Whereas there is a sensitive area (indigenous peoples) in the region surrounding this project site and the project requires site acquisition, it will not cause resettlement and appropriate consideration will be made through compensation. A plan for indigenous peoples will be established and implemented.

(1 0) Others, Monitoring

In this project, air and water quality, and noise levels as well as ecosystems will be monitored.
